Dear ICANN staff,

I`m writing this letter on behalf of Association UNINET - a Bulgarian association of domain registrars, IT service companies and VOIP providers, which has been promoting the use of IDN in Bulgaria since 2007.

In May 2010, the Bulgarian IDN ccTLD application in the Fast Track Process was rejected by the DNS Stability panel. Many people have criticized the lack of transparency and appeal options in this process, but after the ongoing public comment period we hope that it would be amended by the ICANN Board and the Bulgarian government (as a requester) will have the chance to apply for a re-evaluation of the proposed string.

Therefore I request the following information, connected with the Bulgarian IDN ccTLD Fast Track application:

1. The DNS Stability panel working criteria (or parts of it) that were applied to evaluate and subsequently reject the Bulgarian application.
2. The decision of the DNS Stability panel, used to reject the Bulgarian application.

We will need the requested information to be able to participate adequately in the possible re-evaluation request, that would be submitted if the IDN ccTLD Fast Track Process is amended as a result of the received public comments.
