Thank you for the recent opportunity to testify before the Subcommittee on Courts and Competition Policy at the 23 September 2009 hearing on "Expansion of Top Level Domains and its Effects on Competition." I have reviewed the transcript of my testimony and enclose my corrections to the transcript.

For ease in review of my corrections, I am enclosing: (1) a copy of the transcript with corrections interlineated in red and (2) a chart noting the corrections by line number and context.

I am also enclosing an Addendum to my oral testimony, with two items for clarification of statements I made at the hearing. I made a comment to that effect in my testimony at lines 1210-24 of the transcript, and now request that two of the sentences within that section be modified to better reflect the current state of the debate within ICANN.
