	DECLARATION OF JESSE W. MARKHAM, JR. IN SUPPORT OF CFIT'S APPLICATION FOR A TRO sf-2042144	

 I, Jesse W. Markham, Jr., declare as follows:

- I am a partner in the law firm of Morrison & Foerster LLP, counsel of record for Plaintiff Coalition For ICANN Transparency Inc. ("CFIT") in the above-entitled action. I am duly admitted to practice before this Court and all courts in the State of California. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and could competently testify to them if called as a witness. I submit this declaration in support of CFIT's Application for a Temporary Restraining Order.
- 2. I was informed this afternoon that Kurt Pritz of the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") announced today in Vancouver, British Columbia that the proposed 2005 .com Registry Agreement which is the subject of this TRO application would not be put to a vote by the ICANN Board during its meeting this week in Vancouver.
- 3. Having received this information, I telephoned Jeffrey LeVee of the Jones Day law firm, who is representing ICANN in this matter, to inform him of this announcement and to explore a possible stipulation to freeze matters at the status quo until the Court is able to decide CFIT's upcoming motion for a preliminary injunction.
- 4. Mr. LeVee told me that ICANN had previously decided that it would not have a Board vote on the proposed 2005 .com Registry Agreement this week. He also said that ICANN does not have any Board meetings scheduled for the rest of this year.
- 5. Notwithstanding these facts, Mr. LeVee refused to agree to a proposed freeze at the status quo. He told me that ICANN plans to hold its Board meeting at the end of the public discussions this week in Vancouver and will decide at that Board meeting how and when the matter will be put to a vote. Although there is no Board meeting scheduled prior to the end of 2005, Mr. LeVee informed me that ICANN could convene a special Board meeting to consider the issue with one week's notice.
- 6. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a true and correct copy of a letter dated as of this date to Mr. LeVee from myself.
