PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6) and 12(b)(1), Defendant Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") will and hereby does move the Court to dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint. Pursuant to the Court's December 4, 2012 Order denying the parties' Stipulation and [Proposed] Order Regarding Briefing Schedule on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss (Docket No. 23) and given the fact that December 31, 2012 is closed for hearing, this motion shall be heard on January 7, 2013, at 1:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard in the courtroom of the Honorable Percy Anderson, United States District Judge, United States District Court, 312 N. Spring Street, Los Angeles, California 90012.

This motion is made pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6) on the grounds that Plaintiff's entire Complaint, and each of its claims, is barred by a release of ICANN executed by Plaintiff on October 6, 2000. This motion is further made on the grounds that Plaintiff has failed to allege facts plausibly suggesting that ICANN has violated Section 1 or Section 2 of the Sherman Act, California's Cartwright Act, California's Unfair Competition Law, or that ICANN has tortiously interfered with Plaintiff's contracts or prospective economic advantage. This motion is also made pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1) on the grounds that Plaintiff's claims for trademark infringement and common law unfair competition are not ripe for adjudication and are insufficient to meet Article III's justiciability requirement.

This motion is based on this Amended Notice of Motion and Motion, the previously-filed Memorandum of Points and Authorities (Docket No. 19, Attachment 1) and Request for Judicial Notice (Docket No. 20), the complete files and records in this action, including Plaintiff's Complaint, oral argument of counsel, and such other and further matters this Court may consider.
