ICANN organization has published an <u>Advisory[icann.org]</u>to provide guidance regarding Specification 11 Section 3(b) in response to questions from some registry operators concerning what practices they can implement to establish compliance with the provision.

This Advisory offers one voluntary approach registry operators may adopt to perform technical analyses to assess security threats and produce statistical reports as required by Spec 11 (3)(b). It should be noted registry operators who use the practices as set forth in this Advisory are not automatically deemed to be compliant. In all cases, registry operators remain subject to the same level of case-by-case, fact-based inquiry processes and audit to evidence compliance.
