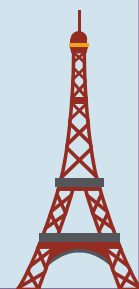

Visit the world's largest art museum: The Louvre Museum is widely considered the greatest art museum in the world. Home to Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa, the Louvre boasts one of the most impressive art collections that dates back to ancient civilization.
