Following our last GDPR <u>update</u>, ICANN org has published <u>additional details</u> with regard to submitting a model to provide registration directory services and meeting other data retention requirements while remaining compliant with the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

We are looking forward to receiving your proposed models submitted in response to the <u>Statement from Contractual Compliance</u>. We encourage the community to work together to align its models prior to submission. Fewer models will ease the impact on end-users and operational processes for all. Those models will be published and shared with Hamilton, the European law firm engaged to assist ICANN, for their consideration.

Proposals should consider the <u>additional guidelines</u> and be submitted to our Global Support Center by emailing <u>globalsupport@icann.org</u>. As a reminder, submission of a model does not guarantee approval or temporary deferral from contractual obligations.
