Subject: Launch of Centralized Zone Data Service portal Refresh

Dear CZDS User,

Today, **28 January 2019**, the ICANN organization introduced an updated portal for the Centralized Zone Data Service (CZDS) at <a href="https://czds.icann.org/">https://czds.icann.org/</a> [czds.icann.org]. It includes an enhanced user experience and a platform infrastructure change for a more stable, flexible, scalable and secure environment.

Your current account data has been migrated to the refreshed CZDS portal along with your previously-approved zone file access. You may begin using the service immediately by following the below instructions.

## First-time login to the new CZDS portal

Whether you access CZDS from the portal or application programming interface (API), all CZDS end-users must login for the first time via the updated portal at <a href="https://czds.icann.org/">https://czds.icann.org/</a> [czds.icann.org]. For security reasons your existing password was not migrated, so before you can begin using the CZDS service you must reset your password and verify your account profile.

Note that your CZDS username has been updated to reflect your current CZDS email address and cannot be changed without creating a new CZDS account.

## **CZDS API Change**

As previously communicated, this update includes a new CZDS API that replaces the legacy CZDS API. The updated CZDS API specification, along with a reference implementation, can be found at <a href="https://github.com/icann/czds-api-client-java">https://github.com/icann/czds-api-client-java</a> [github.com].

## **CZDS Help**

The help section of the CZDS portal has been expanded to include service details, navigation instructions, and descriptions of functions available in the updated portal. In addition, you will find a pre-recorded webinar for training purposes.
