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PUSHINSKY DECLARATION ISO DEMURRER AND REQUEST FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE

DECLARATION OF AMANDA PUSHINSKY

I, Amanda Pushinsky, declare:

- 1. I am attorney licensed to practice law before all courts of the State of California and am one of the attorneys of record for defendant Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN"). I have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein, and if called to do so as a witness, I could and would competently testify to them. I make this declaration in support of ICANN's Request for Judicial Notice and Demurrer to Second Amended Complaint.

- 8. Following Plaintiff's initiation of this lawsuit in October 2016, counsel for ICANN communicated on several occasions, by phone and email, with counsel for Plaintiff, Jeff Kirk at O'Conner and Associates. In these communications, counsel for ICANN explained that ICANN was not an "necessary party" to the litigation, and therefore should not be joined as such, because ICANN has no ability or authority to transfer the "funding.com" domain name. In response to these communications, Mr. Kirk provided ICANN an extension to respond to the Second Amended Complaint ("SAC") while he investigated ICANN's position.

- 9. On January 12, 2017, Mr. Kirk sent an email to counsel for ICANN stating that because ICANN was mentioned in the contract between Plaintiff and defendant B52 Media regarding the sale of the disputed domain name, Plaintiff would not dismiss ICANN from the case.
- 10. Accordingly, pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 430.41, on February 21, 2017, counsel for ICANN informed Mr. Kirk that ICANN intended to file a demurrer, and requested a meet and confer. A meet and confer was scheduled for February 22, 2017 at 2:30 p.m.
- 11. Prior to the meet and confer, counsel for ICANN sent Mr. Kirk an email summarizing ICANN's grounds for a demurrer, and providing multiple documents supporting ICANN's position that ICANN is not a "necessary party" to the litigation because ICANN cannot effectuate a transfer of a domain name, and therefore cannot provide the relief requested by Plaintiff. Mr. Kirk responded that he would confer with his client, and suggested the meet and confer be rescheduled to February 23, 2017.
- 12. On February 23, 2017, at 2:30 pm, counsel for ICANN conferred by telephone with Mr. Kirk regarding the basis for ICANN's demurrer. Mr. Kirk indicated he would discuss the matter with his client, and provided ICANN an open extension to respond to the SAC.
- Atallah, the President of the Global Domains Division of ICANN. The declaration states that registrars are the entities that are able to transfer domain names such as "funding.com" from one registrant to another, not ICANN, and that ICANN does not have the power or authority to transfer domain names. Mr. Kirk responded on March 8, 2017, stating that he would review the declaration.
- 14. Having heard no further response from Mr. Kirk several weeks later, counsel for ICANN emailed Mr. Kirk to check on the progress of his review of the declaration. Mr. Kirk did not respond.
- 15. On April 4, 2017, counsel for ICANN called Mr. Kirk to check on the status of his review. Mr. Kirk indicated he was busy with another matter, and would require a few additional weeks to review the contents of the declaration.

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
