Please note that the ICANN organization has revised the Protection of IGO and INGO Identifiers in All gTLDs Policy, currently available here: <new link that looks like this

In January 2019, the ICANN Board adopted GNSO Policy recommendations regarding Protections for Certain Red Cross and Red Crescent Names in All Generic Top-Level Domains. This policy is the implementation of those recommendations. Resolutions by the ICANN Board can be found here <https://www.icann.org/resources/board-material/resolutions-2019-01-27-en#2.d>

Implementation of this Policy is limited to the names pertaining to the Certain Red Cross & Red Crescent Names at the Second Level of the Domain Name System. Pursuant to the contractual obligation to comply with consensus policies, which now include updated names list for Red Cross & Red Crescent names, generic top-level domain (gTLD) registries and registrars are required to implement the reservation of the updated names list of this Policy no later than 1 August 2020. The effective date term “no later than” is used to allow the implementers to make their updates to their reserved names immediately upon this notice but no later than the policy effective date of 1 August 2020.
