



Dear Registrar,

As the result of the termination of the accreditation of Pheenix, Inc. (IANA 888), the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOIs) from ICANN-accredited registrars that would like to assume sponsorship of the generic top-level domain (gTLD) names that were managed by this registrar. ICANN's preference is to initiate a bulk transfer of the affected gTLD names to a single gaining registrar.

The terminated registrar sponsors approximately 6,500 registrations in total in the following TLDs: .BIZ, .CLUB, .COM, .INFO, .MOBI, .NET, .ORG, .PRO, .SITE, .TECH, .TOP, .WIKI, and .XYZ.

ICANN-accredited registrars that want to be considered as a gaining registrar must be in good standing with regard to all ICANN obligations and have agreements in place with the registry operators of the aforementioned gTLDs. All interested parties must submit a completed Expression of Interest (see attached) by email to registrar@icann.org **no later than 23:59 UTC Tuesday, 15 June 2021.**

This request for EOI is made pursuant to the De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure posted at <https://www.icann.org/en/system/files/files/dartp-11jul13-en.pdf>. ICANN reserves the right to consider any or none of the EOIs submitted in response to this request, and/or to select or approve a bulk-transfer recipient outside of this process.
