



Dear Registrar,

The ICANN organization will launch version 2.0 of the Naming Services portal (NSp) for registrars on **28 October 2019**. This version will enable ICANN to retire the aging Registrar Application and Data Access Resource (RADAR) system and will make NSp the system of record for Registrar data. In addition to enabling primary contacts to manage the data for their registrar in NSp, this release will enable future functionality to be added to NSp for registrars, such as viewing and responding to tickets from ICANN's contractual compliance.

What to expect?

- 21 October: RADAR will become read-only to prepare for data migration to the NSp.
- From 25 to 28 October the registrar portion of the NSp will be unavailable.
- 28 October: RADAR will be retired and NSp version 2.0 will become available. The following communications will be sent to the registrar primary contact and group administrators:
 - A notice of system availability will be sent to existing NSp users.
 - Activation emails will be sent to users that are not currently active in the portal.
