This Court, having read and considered the papers submitted by the parties, 1 2 and finding good cause therefor, orders that the motion to dismiss pursuant to 3 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure section 12(b)(6) filed by defendant Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers is hereby SUSTAINED without 4 leave to amend as to plaintiff VeriSign, Inc.'s ("VeriSign") first claim for relief for 5 violation of section 1 of the Sherman Act, second claim for relief for injunctive 6 relief for breach of contract, third claim for relief for damages for breach of 7 contract, fourth claim for relief for interference with contractual relations, fifth 8 claim for relief for specific performance of contract and injunctive relief, and sixth 9 10 claim for relief for damages for breach of contract.
