1 This Court, having read and considered the papers submitted by the parties,
2 and finding good cause therefor, orders that the Special Motion to Strike (C.C.P.
3 section 425.16) filed by defendant Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and
4 Numbers ("ICANN") is hereby GRANTED as to plaintiff VeriSign, Inc.'s
5 ("VeriSign") amended second claim for relief for injunctive relief for breach of
6 contract, amended third claim for relief for damages for breach of contract,
7 amended fourth claim for relief for interference with contractual relations, and
8 amended fifth claim for relief for specific performance of contract and injunctive
9 relief. VeriSign's amended second, third, fourth, and fifth causes of action are
10 hereby dismissed with prejudice pursuant to California's anti-SLAPP statute.

11 This Court finds further that ICANN is entitled to recover its costs and
12 attorneys' fees. ICANN may submit a formal motion to recover its attorneys' fees
13 and costs within ten days of the entry of this order.
